Below are the definitions for each category heading within the scholarship bulletin. If you have further questions, please see a counselor!

**Title of Scholarship:** The title gives you information as to the scholarship source.

**Amount:** Scholarship amount may vary or may be specific. Renewable scholarships are those that can be used each year if you meet specific criteria (e.g. maintain a 3.2 GPA during your first year of college).

**Deadline:** When the scholarship application is due. **Watch for this date** since it may tell you when the application must be postmarked or it may tell you when their office must receive it. Remember to give a counselor, teachers, etc. at least three weeks to write recommendations otherwise you may miss the deadline!

**Eligibility:** This box will tell you what you must do to qualify for the scholarship. If you are in doubt, check with a counselor.

**Additional information:** In this column, you will find any additional information you may need to know and the website.

**\*\*Please note that colleges and universities offer their own scholarships. Other than the University of MN or other very popular college with DeLaSalle students, these are NOT listed here. Check the college website for school specific scholarships.**
