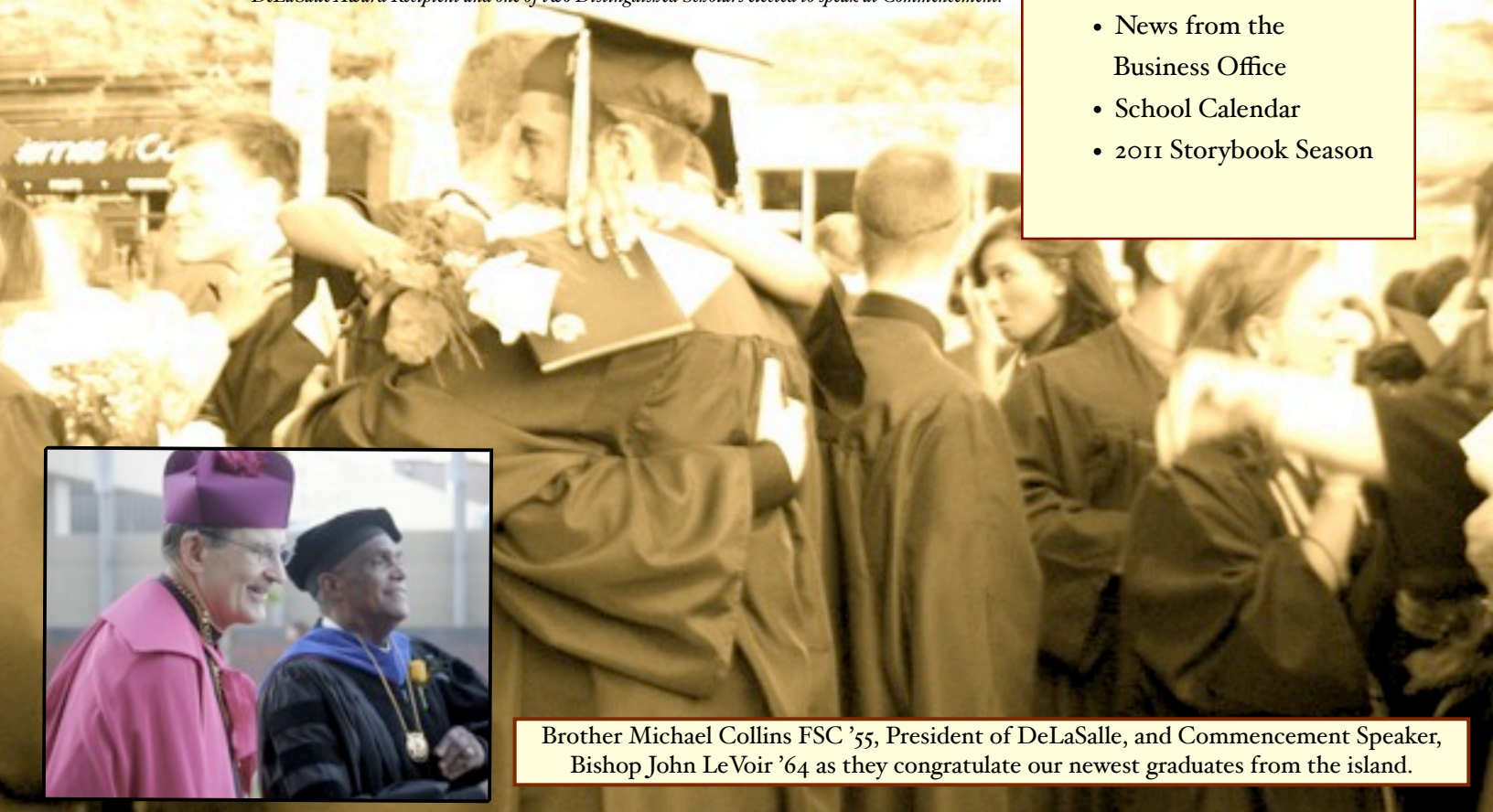

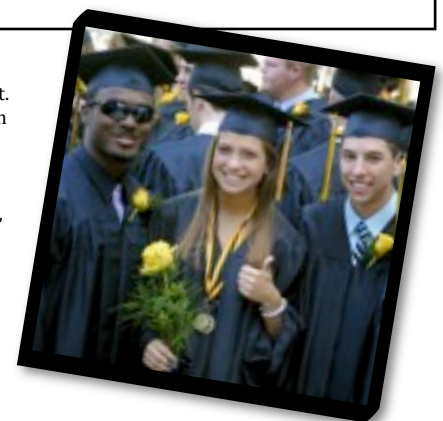

SERVICE TRIP

This June, 43 DeLaSalle students and 4 DeLaSalle staff members took a week of travel to New Orleans on a service trip to help with the continuing efforts to rebuild after Hurricane Katrina. Working through 100 degree temps, here's what they accomplished:

- Put together 60 meals for the homeless
- Worked over 36 hours in 5 days with Habitat
- Installed 889 square feet of hardwood floors
- Installed 255 square feet of tile
- Put up 1230 feet of chain-link fence
- Dug 135 18" deep holes for the fence poles
- Laid 150 square feet of cement for sidewalks
- Painted the interior and exterior of homes
- Made window cladding and so much more
- Twelve students served dinner to the homeless at the New Orleans Mission.
- The kids left NOLA with a new appreciation for their lives back home.

Insurance: At orientation, families will be asked to choose from one of the available insurance options for the iPads, and DeLaSalle will require a check before the iPad is issued. These two plans will be discussed in more detail during the orientation session, **but please remember to bring a checkbook to the orientation.**

- DeLaSalle's *Annual Protection Plan* carries a \$50.00/year cost (\$100.00/family max) and protects the device against any physical damage.
- The *Deposit Protection Plan* requires a \$499 security deposit, and is refundable upon the safe return of the device. Under this plan, the deposit will only be cashed if damage or loss occurs.
